2.6.4 Involvement in family court proceedings in cases of separation/divorce involving parents of underage children

Aim:

to ensure child welfare in conflictual separation/divorce proceedings

"Facilitation of agreement" in parental conflicts (Section 156 FamFG)

Role of the youth welfare office	Role of the family court
Article 50 of Book 8 of the Social Code: Involvement in family court proceedings involving children	Section 162 FamFG Cooperation of the Youth Welfare Office: In proceedings that concern the person of the child, the court shall hear the Youth Welfare Office.
 Counselling and support for parents 	 Involvement/hearing of the youth welfare office
 Preparation for court appearances 	 De-escalation and dispute resolution: joint agreements
 Submission of expert opinions on socio-educational 	and settlements
aspects of the case	 Assessment of child welfare
	 Appointment of a guardian ad litem for children (by default)
	Decisions on custody/visitation rights

Cooperation with and involvement of persons with custodial rights, children and adolescents (e.g., through hearings or a guardian *ad litem*)

Involvement of further persons and/or institutions, e.g., child guidance office (where required)
